New Artwork Supports Healing Environment for Cancer Patients

Trillium Health Partners Unveils Generous Donation from ArtWorks for Cancer Foundation

January 19, 2018 (*Mississauga*, *ON*) –Yesterday, Trillium Health Partners (THP) and Trillium Health Partners Foundation (THPF) celebrated a generous donation of artwork today from ArtWorks for Cancer Foundation (AWFC) to the Queensway Health Centre's Betty and Buster Lockwood Cancer Detection and Treatment Centre and the Credit Valley Hospital's Michèle S. Darling Women's Imaging and Assessment Centre.

Trillium Health Partners is the first hospital to receive donated artwork from AWFC. ArtWorks for Cancer Foundation was founded by one of Trillium Health Partners' physician, Dr. Michael Weinberg, who along with AWFC team members created partnerships linking hospitals with artwork donors.

Each of the members of the AWFC team have been touched by cancer and want to transform clinical oncology areas in hospitals across the province of Ontario into warm, hopeful, healing spaces for patients and their families.

Some of the AWFC members donated from their own collections. The additional donors are made up of artists, dealers, estates, corporations and dealers who wish to improve the space cancer patients spend their time in. Each of the pieces were carefully selected with input from patients through THP's cancer program's Patient and Family Advisory Council.
