Hospital marks 10-year anniversary with accomplishments that will shape the future of health care

June 7, 2022 (MISSISSAUGA, ON) – Yesterday at Trillium Health Partners' (THP), the hospital shared its achievements from the past year, as it continued to respond to the largest health care emergency of our generation.

Over the past 12 months, facing new COVID-19 variants and pandemic restrictions, THP continued its comprehensive pandemic response effort and, working with its partners, came together to protect and care for the community. In total, THP's team of over 10,600 staff and 1,400 professional staff cared for more than 5,000 patients with COVID-19, completed over 283,000 COVID-19 tests at its Assessment Centres and worked with community partners to administer more than 528,000 vaccines.

"I'm deeply grateful to our professional staff, nurses, allied health professionals, and enabling staff who are committed to delivering care for the community in the face of the pandemic," said Michèle Darling, Board Chair, THP. "Thank you for always living our values of compassion, excellence and courage in serving those who need us the most."

This year, THP celebrated its 10th anniversary and marked several significant achievements that addressed both immediate and long-term care needs of the Mississauga and West Toronto community:

- Announcing Trillium HealthWorks the largest health care infrastructure renewal project in Canadian history – to meet the community's growing and changing needs and help shape the future of health care for our community and beyond. In addition to stronger community partnerships, Trillium HealthWorks means building The Peter Gilgan Mississauga Hospital and expanding the future home of The Gilgan Family Queensway Health Centre.
- Receiving an historic \$105 million gift from renowned philanthropist Peter Gilgan, the largest donation to a hospital in Canadian history, in support of Trillium HealthWorks.
- Becoming the first hospital in Eastern Canada to introduce HyperArc, an innovative cancer treatment technology that will improve health outcomes, significantly reduce wait times and increase accessibility to treatment.
- Launching Partners Community Health, an independent not-for-profit organization, focused on bringing health care services together around the needs of people living in Mississauga and West Toronto.



- Continuing construction on two new long-term care homes on Speakman Drive in Mississauga, as part of the province's Accelerated Build Pilot Program, which will add 632 much needed long-term care beds and health services for the community.
- Working with local and regional partners, THP supported a unique community-based model to provide oral anti-viral treatments for COVID-19 to those with a higher risk of severe illness.
- Raising a record \$183.3 million from the community, an increase of 152% from last year, through more than 112,000 donations and over 100 community events.

"Throughout the year, THP was so grateful for the support of our community and health care partners, as well as local, regional and provincial levels of government, to guide a co-ordinated pandemic response and champion the health care needs of the community," said Karli Farrow, President and CEO, THP. "Over the next 10 years, THP is well positioned to drive significant change to build a new kind of health care. We will continue to nurture our community partnerships, build on our clinical expertise and commit to innovation to help us succeed."
