Instructions for Emergency Department:

Target: IV antibiotics initiated within 2 hours of ER presentation

Definition: Absolute Neutrophil Count < 1x 109 cells/L + fever >38.3oC

Work-Up: CBC with differential, electrolytes, Cr, liver function, Calcium, phosphate, magnesium, Blood cultures x 2 (via CVAD if present), urine culture CXR *Treatment:* Administer FN antibiotic therapy according to institutional FN protocol. If no protocol exists, please refer to the IDSA guideline on FN management (www.idsociety.org)

- □ 38.3°C (100.9°F) or more,
