How to Get Checked for Breast Cancer

Getting a mammogram

A mammogram is a highly effective screening test for breast cancer. A mammogram is an x-ray of the breast that can find abnormal changes in the breast, even when they may be too small to feel or see.



50-74 years

Most people aged 50 – 74 years should have a mammogram every two years. Anyone with a family history of cancer may be eligible sooner – talk to a healthcare provider.
