Ontario Works & Ontario Disability Support Program

If you are receiving support through Ontario Works (OW) or Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP), transportation costs are paid when the cost is more than \$15 per month.

A Mandatory Special Necessities (MSN) Benefit Request form must be completed to receive transportation costs. Speak to your OW or ODSP worker for more information about transportation to and from medical appointments.

Emergency costs can be covered using receipts. A note requesting reimbursement and specifying the destination and the mileage is also acceptable; however, receipts such as a parking receipt should also be included.

Wheelchair Taxi

Several taxi companies have accessible taxis. These vehicles may need to be booked ahead of time. Check your local listings for more information. There may be additional cost for a specialized vehicle.
